**Late Payment Fee** ----- 1.5%/month  
Late payment fee will be assessed on all balances outstanding over 30 days, with a minimum late charge of \$10. Late charges will continue to accrue each month the payment is late.

**Insufficient Funds Bank Fee** ----- \$35.00  
Fee is assessed on all checks and automatic debits returned for insufficient funds.

### **Collection/Attorney Fees**

Parents are responsible for any fees and expenses incurred by GLC related to collecting delinquent accounts.

### **Financial Assistance**

Parents should discuss this with the GLC Director if appropriate. GLC strives each year to provide funds for financial assistance to students who qualify. Such funding varies from year to year depending on fundraising success and budget constraints. GLC does not guarantee that funding will be available each year. The student must apply for financial assistance through "FAST" (Financial Aid for School Tuition). This is an independent agency that determines eligibility. The results of this review are submitted to GLC by FAST. The Finance Committee reviews all student requests for financial aid, the information from FAST, and the amount of financial aid available and decides how the scholarship funds will be allocated. The applicant

will be notified in writing whether or not scholarship funding will be award to them, as well as the amount, if applicable.
